

## Release Notes: Legends 4K™ Firmware 6.0.21 for Legends Pinball 4KP (June 28, 2024)

## **Highlights**

A new System Update v6.0.21 for all Legends Pinball 4KP devices is now available! This update focuses on enhancements to Legends 4K™ PinballNet™ and the addition of On Device Purchases!

PinballNet<sup>™</sup> has its first enhancement! In addition to PinballNet<sup>™</sup> having its own Favorites filter, users will now be able to filter by Publisher, Series, or whether a table has been previously Downloaded.

On Device Purchase is a new feature that is included in this firmware as an Open Beta which allows customers to purchase table/game packs directly from their device. We will be updating this feature in future firmware releases. Frequently Asked Questions can be found here.

The system update will automatically appear for download when you power on your internet connected Legends  $4K^{TM}$  device.

## **Known Issues Being Worked On**

- 1. Improvements for flipper lag in Zen pinball tables are still in progress.
- 2. Accelerometer can not be adjusted or disabled.
- 3. The plunger sensitivity has a small dead zone and minimal lag affecting visual feedback. A fix is being worked on for future builds.
- 4. On rare occasions, CE-4K may crash to a black screen with a "Critical Error" pop-up. If this happens, you should restart your ALP 4KP machine.
- 5. Wireless Pairing does not scan automatically on some rare occasions. In this case, the Bluetooth devices will not be listed. Restart your ALP 4KP machine to fix this problem.
- 6. After playing a game from an FDX thumb drive, the FDX thumb drive can no longer be dismounted.
- On rare occasions when you try to connect to a Wi-Fi network, CE-4K may crash.
- 8. Bluetooth headsets are currently not fully supported. While they will pair in the Wireless Pairing screen, audio will not be sent to them.
- 9. Arcade Play Link does not support portrait mode.
- 10. Switching the Flipper and Nudge buttons inside of the Pinball Settings does not function within Zen tables.
- 11. PinballNet™ users that previously downloaded a Zaccaria Deluxe table may be notified of an update. Users will need to uninstall any previously downloaded Zaccaria Deluxe tables by navigating to Settings → Data Manager → Manage Storage, select each Zaccaria Deluxe table previously deleted from PinballNet™ and then choose Delete Package.
