

FAQ: Private Tournaments

(July 30, 2026)

1. What are Private Tournaments?

A: Private Tournaments are invitation-only competitions that let you challenge friends across supported leaderboard games. Create your own tournament, select up to three games, set the competition schedule, and share the generated invitation code with the players you want to invite.

2. Where can I find Private Tournaments?

A: Private Tournaments are available in two places:

- On the AtGames Leaderboards website [HERE](#) under My Scores → Private Tournaments.
- In Legends Access App under Leaderboards → Private Tournaments.

Sign in with the same AtGames account on either platform to access the tournaments you created or joined.

3. How do I create a Private Tournament?

A: Open Private Tournaments and select Create Tournament. Enter a tournament name, add an optional description, select the start and end times and time zone, and choose up to three supported leaderboard games. Select Create and Get Code to create the tournament and receive its invitation code.

4. How many games can I add?

A: You can select one, two, or three supported leaderboard games for each Private Tournament.

5. Which games are available for Private Tournaments?

A: The tournament creation screen displays all currently supported leaderboard games. Game availability may vary and may be updated over time.

6. How do I invite players?

A: After creating a tournament, share its generated invitation code with the people you want to challenge. Every tournament member can reopen the tournament and share the invitation code with additional players.

7. How do I join a Private Tournament?

A: Open Private Tournaments, select Join with Code, and enter the invitation code shared by a tournament member. Once you join, the tournament will appear in your Private Tournaments list.

8. Are invitation codes case-sensitive?

A: No. Private Tournament invitation codes are not case-sensitive.

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9. Can another tournament member share the invitation code?

A: Yes. Every tournament member can reopen the tournament and share its invitation code.

10. Who can view the tournament standings?

A: Only tournament members can view the tournament's overall and individual game standings, schedule, status, and other member-only details.

11. What standings are available?

A: Each Private Tournament includes:

- An Overall ranking calculated across all selected tournament games.
- A separate ranking for each selected game.
- The tournament's current status, schedule, and member-only details.

12. Where can I view the standings?

A: Tournament members can view standings on the AtGames Leaderboards website [HERE](#) or in Legends Access App. Sign in with the same AtGames account used to create or join the tournament.

13. How many Private Tournaments can I participate in?

A: You can participate in up to three active or upcoming Private Tournaments at one time. This total includes tournaments you joined and tournaments you created. Finished tournaments do not count toward this limit.

14. How many Private Tournaments can I create?

A: You can have one active or upcoming tournament that you created at a time. After that tournament ends, you can create another one, provided you have not reached the overall participation limit.

15. Why can't I create or join another tournament?

A: You may have reached one of the participation limits:

- You are already participating in three active or upcoming Private Tournaments.
- You already created one tournament that is active or upcoming.

Finished tournaments do not count toward these limits.

16. Can I create or join tournaments from different devices?

A: Private Tournaments are connected to your AtGames account. Sign in with the same account on the AtGames Leaderboards website or in Legends Access App to access the tournaments you created or joined.

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17. What happens when a tournament reaches its scheduled end time?

A: The competition ends and stops accepting new activity. Existing scores and final standings remain available to tournament members.

18. Can I end my tournament early?

A: Yes. The tournament creator can end an active tournament from its details before the scheduled end time. The competition will stop accepting new activity, but existing scores and standings will remain available.

19. Can I reopen a tournament after ending it early?

A: No. Ending a tournament cannot be undone. Confirm the standings before ending the competition because an ended tournament cannot be reopened.

20. Can tournament members still view a finished tournament?

A: Yes. Tournament members can reopen a finished tournament to review its scores, standings, schedule, and other tournament details.

21. Can someone view or join my tournament without an invitation code?

A: Private Tournament details and standings are available only to tournament members. Players must receive and enter the tournament's invitation code to join.
