

Release Notes: Williams™ Pinball: Star Trek™: The Next Generation Legends Single Premium Pack for Legends 4K™ Pinball Machines Update (September 19, 2024)

Williams™ Pinball: Star Trek™: The Next Generation Legends Single Premium Pack Version 1.18

The re-release of Williams™ Pinball: Star Trek™: The Next Generation comes with the following improvements and enhancements.

- **Improved Input Latency:** Enhanced support now offers reduced latency, providing a smoother gaming experience.
 - Input latency has been reduced from 121.57ms down to 83.67ms.
- **Improved Audio Latency:** Enhanced support now offers improved audio latency, providing a more responsive audio gaming experience.
- **Flash Drive X (FDX) Support:** Williams™ Pinball: Star Trek™: The Next Generation can now be saved and played directly from Flash Drive X (FDX).
- **Improved Tournament Participation:** You no longer have to beat your local Top 5 scores to participate in Tournaments.
- **Volume Improvements:** Normalized the volume of the sound channels within the table to be about the same as non-Zen tables.
- **Backglass images can now be stretched.**
- **Playfield Aprons have been improved.**

The Williams™ Pinball: Star Trek™: The Next Generation Legends Single Premium Pack table is playable on all currently released Legends 4K™ machines and will be compatible with future AtGames Legends 4K™ devices.

Known Issues Being Worked On:

1. Switching the Flipper and Nudge buttons inside of the Pinball Settings does not function properly within Zen pinball tables.
2. When the Haptic Feedback is set to "Disable", Haptic Feedback and Solenoids will not be available in Williams™ Pinball: Star Trek™: The Next Generation. Changing this setting to "Enable" will allow the use these features. This will be corrected in an upcoming release.
3. As stated in Known Issue #1 in the Firmware v6.0.28 Release Notes, found [here](#), after playing a not-yet-updated Zen table, updated Zen tables will experience micro-stuttering. Restarting the machine will resolve this issue.
4. If the user beats the lowest score in the table's built-in "Honor Roll" (the lowest "Honor Roll" score is 200 million points each time the table is launched), they will be asked to enter their initials on the DMD. If the player uses the Start or A buttons, the system will duplicate the letter chosen. This will be corrected in a future update. In the meantime, using the plunger to enter an initial will not cause a duplicate entry.
